Harry Hynes Memorial Hospice offers an in-patient unit at Ascension Via Christi St Francis, called the **Hospice Center**, for families who would prefer to receive our services outside the home. While the patient's family is visiting their loved one, it is our hope to make their visit as comfortable as possible. While compassion, understanding and support are our main focuses, in an act of hospitality, we also provide snacks for visitors. This small act of generosity can make a big impact on a grieving family.

Below is the "wish list" of items that are wanted to enhance our patients, families, or staff's experience. Please consider designating your gift to one of the following areas of need:

- Gift cards (Aldi's, Kroger/Dillons, Target, Walmart, Gas Cards, Home Goods) to be used for food and materials in the patient care, inpatient unit and bereavement
- Gift cards to Jo Ann Fabrics/Michael's/Hobby Lobby (used for crafts, Life Enrichment supplies, Connections program items, and Memory Bear supplies)
- Forever Stamps from USPS
- Nightgowns and Pajama Sets- Seasonal, various sizes, men and women, sizes M-3 XL
- Men's flannel shirts in M-L-XL for Hospice Center patients
- T-shirts Colored, sizes M-3 XL
- Hospital twin-sized cotton sheets for the Hospice Center
- Any colored (no white or cream) hand towels and washcloths for our Hospice Center patients Kitchen towels for the Hospice Center
- Soft blankets (twin and full) for the Hospice Center
- Weighted Blankets Weighted blankets provide pressure and sensory input for individuals with dementia and can be used as a calming tool for sleep
- CD players Small portable players to be used in nursing homes
- Locked boxes For medication safety/storage
- Pocket Talkers Assists patients who have difficulty hearing
- Crossword Puzzle Books
- Word Search Books
- Adult Coloring Books with Colored Pencils
- Sensory/Fidget Aids for Adults
- Garden center/nursery gift certificates (to be used for the Memory Garden)
- Hanging Flower Baskets (Spring and Summer)
- Standing Potted Plants (Spring and Summer)
